- 1. 'Create a New FSA ID' for both you and your parent (if required) with the U.S. Department of Education at https://fsaid.ed.gov.
- 2. Gather yours and your parent's (if required) federal tax documents (2018 & 2019 1040 forms) and log on to https://www.fafsa.ed.gov and complete:

Add school code by looking for your Platt College campus.

3. Please complete your loan documents by logging on to https://studentaid.gov.

Please make sure you select your Platt College campus.

- Complete Entrance Counseling (select Undergraduate Student).
- Complete Master Promissory Note (select Subsidized/Unsubsidized).
- 4. FOR YOUR PARENT TO COMPLETE ONLY (IF REQUIRED): Your parent will need to log on https://studentaid.gov with their assigned FSA ID and Complete Master Promissory (select Parent PLUS).
